Lower Umpqua Hospital Auxiliary provides services to the Hospital, its patients and the community following the Partners in Care philosophy.

Who are our Auxiliary Members?

The more than 50 volunteers of the Lower Umpqua Hospital Auxiliary include homemakers and retired business men and women.

Dues are only \$5/year for active members, \$10/year for associate members.

Meetings are held on the third Thursday of the month in the hospital conference room at 12:00 p.m. (No meetings are held June, July or August).

New members are requested to attend a short orientation program which includes a tour of the hospital.

In what ways does the Auxiliary provide assistance to the Hospital?

- § Volunteers in purple smocks or vests staff the information desk in the front lobby from 9AM to 3PM, Monday through Friday. They assist patients, family and visitors as needed.
- § The gift shop, located in the hospital lobby, is managed by the Auxiliary with the profits benefiting the hospital. It is staffed by volunteers from 10 – 4pm Monday - Friday.
- § Auxiliary members assist with hospital tours, health fairs, Halloween activities and Thanksgiving dinner in Extended Care.



- § The Auxiliary membership is a cornerstone of hospital fundraising. Funds are used for scholarships, medical equipment and other special needs.
- § In the Extended Care Unit, auxiliary members enrich residents' lives with music, letter-writing, readings, crafts and more.
