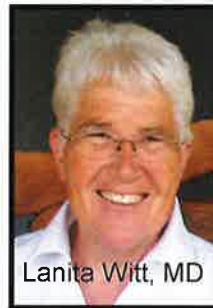

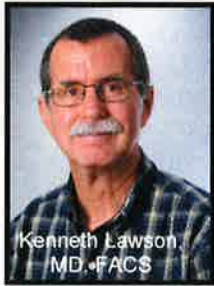

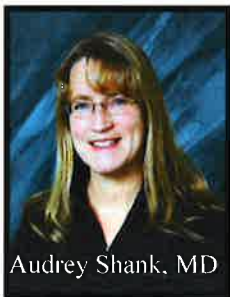
Dr. Lawson is a general surgery practitioner, including endoscopic, laparoscopic and thoracic procedures.

In January 2014, she began working at the LUHD Walk-in Clinic, where she enjoys taking care of all types of patients and their illnesses.



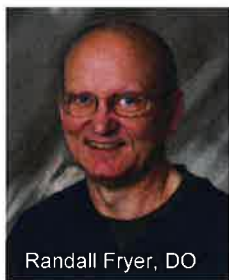
