Lower Umpqua Hospital District is looking for an Occupational Therapist – PRN to provide Occupational Therapy services per state standards and practice act as directed by LUH. Duties to be performed in Acute Care, nursing home, clinical, and pool settings.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES: Essential duties including the following items:

- Adhere to the Code of Ethics as outlined by the AOTA.
- Maintain proficiency within the profession by keeping up with continuing education and license.
- Screens patients for Occupational Therapy needs.
- Completes initial Occupational Therapy evaluation and performs further assessments and testing as needed per plan of care.
- Develops plan of care and performs direct patient care using proper modalities and procedures according to treatment plan.
- Provide regular assessment and revision of the patient's progress toward goal areas.
- Maintain records that accurately reflect patient care and progress to include: evaluations, progress reports, and discharge summaries per regulatory standards.
- Advises, consults, and teaches patient and family members as well as caregivers as indicated.
- Provide supervision for OTA's and rehabilitation aides per state practice act and standards of care.
- Maintain contact with physician regarding occupational therapy plan of care and progress as needed.
- Attends care conferences and interdisciplinary group meetings as requested.
- Participate in Quality Assurance activities as requested
- Participate in quarterly records review as requested.
- Comply with hospital policies and procedures.

MARGINAL DUTIES:

- Answer phones.
- Scheduling patients
- Assist in ordering of linen and supplies.
- Cleaning of treatment rooms.
- Assist other healthcare members – maintaining proper inservices for LUH staff.
- Provide clinical supervision of OT and OTA students and volunteers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduate from an accredited school with degree Occupational Therapy
- License in good standing as a Occupational Therapist in the State of Oregon.
- Must hold a current First Aid and CPR card.

- Must be able to perform physical demands of job duties.
- Good people skills and be a team player.
- Good skills in written and oral communications.
- Must be adaptable to changing work environments.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Must be able to sit, stoop, twist, reach, push, and pull.
- Must be able to lift varying amounts of weight.
- Must be able to communicate via phone, intercom, and person to person.
