Dear Community,

We have received many questions regarding the distribution of the COVID-19 Vaccine. This is an update on what we know as of right now.

We continue to work with the CDC and Oregon Health Authority to stay up to date on guidance and vaccine prioritization. At this time, the CDC has prioritized the vaccine to healthcare workers and first responders. The vaccine is not yet available to the general public. At this time, Lower Umpqua Hospital District is not starting a waiting list for the COVID-19 vaccines for the general public as the guidelines, timeline and delivery dates are still not known. Lower Umpqua Hospital District will continue to work with state and county advisors to develop a comprehensive plan for COVID-19 vaccination.

In the meantime, several additional COVID-19 vaccines are pending FDA review and authorization which will serve to optimize the overall availability of vaccine.
