



# COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

**March 4, 2021**



Yesterday, an additional 199 community members received their second dose of the Moderna vaccine. We were also able to vaccinate six - first doses since vaccine vials hold 10 to 11 doses and we were able to get five additional doses. In total, we were able to give 205 doses yesterday!

We would like to acknowledge and thank our vaccinating team and volunteers which include members from C.E.R.T., Dunes Family Health Care, LUH Admitting, Family Resource Center, LUH Human Resources, LUH Foundation, LUH Infection Control, LUH In-patient Pharmacy, and LUH Surgery.

We are hosting a **COVID-19 Walk-In Vaccination Clinic** for our 75 and older community members tomorrow - Friday, March 5th. Doors open at 11 am at the Reedsport Community Center, 451 Winchester Avenue, Reedsport. Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine will be administered. Pfizer is a two dose vaccine with the second dose being due 21 days after first dose.
