



COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

March 8, 2021



We were fortunate to receive a delivery of the Pfizer vaccine last week. This allowed us to give 281 vaccines to our community members. We held a walk-in clinic on Friday, March 5th starting with the 75 year old and above residents. In being diligent not to waste vaccine, we later invited 70 and 65 year olds to be vaccinated. Our staff has enjoyed seeing the smiling faces of our community while bringing them peace of mind as we work through the vaccination process.

Special shout-out to the LUH EMS team. They have been assisting at the vaccine clinics since January when we began offering the vaccine. They drive to Roseburg to pick up the vaccine and help monitor those who have been vaccinated during clinic events, while continuing to perform their daily job.

Our EMS team provides emergency medical services to residents throughout 650 square miles in coastal Douglas County and the northern part of Coos County, including 24 miles of sand dunes. These areas include approximately 10,000 residents, a large number of tourists and over 1,200 calls per year. They work closely with our local fire departments, law enforcement, US Coast Guard, US Forest Service and other organizations. They, also, provide support to our community at sporting events, medical standbys and monthly CPR classes.
